3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

A holder of the professional certificate of Ventilation Duct Fitter level I:

- is familiar with the good building practice and ensures quality;
- complies with occupational safety requirements for construction works;
- organises his/her work in compliance with regulations and in a safe manner;
- is able to calculate the consumption of materials and the hours of work;
- reads architectural drawings;
- stakes out the main building dimensions under supervision;
- transfers height marks under supervision;
- uses measuring instruments;
- is familiar with general principles of construction and applies them;
- is familiar with building materials and their properties;
- is familiar with the main construction tools and machines;
- is able to stop;
- is familiar and complies with the safety requirements for work involving an open flame;
- is familiar with aerodynamics and acoustics;
- has knowledge of the materials used in the ventilation systems and their properties;
- installs ventilation systems under supervision;

6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

In order to obtain a occupational certificate, the applicant has to prove all his/her competencies required by the occupational standard and by the procedure for awarding of occupational qualification established by the body awarding the occupational qualification.

Ventilation Duct Fitter level I professional qualifications require:

Successful graduation from a vocational education institution in the speciality of construction, or

at least 2 years of professional experience or professional in-service training in the case of applicants without professional vocational education.

The qualifications are awarded without a term.
