- is familiar with general principles of construction and applies them;
- is familiar with building materials and their properties;
- is familiar with the main construction tools and machines;
- is able to strop:
- is familiar and complies with the safety requirements for work involving an open flame;
- is familiar with aerodynamics and acoustics;
- has knowledge of the materials used in the ventilation systems and their properties:
- installs ventilation systems under supervision.

## 6. OFFICIALLY RECOGNISED WAYS OF ACQUIRING THE CERTIFICATE

In order to obtain a occupational certificate, the applicant has to prove all his/her competencies required by the occupational standard and by the procedure for awarding of occupational qualification established by the body awarding the occupational qualification.

Ventilation Duct Fitter level II professional qualifications require:

the level of education recommended is basic education; at least 3 years of professional experience and professional in-service training are required.

One year of professional experience and professional training are required for persons with respective vocational education. The qualifications are awarded without a term.
