Competencies: Preparatory work for cutting timber and timber-based materials - Reading simpler technical drawings of furniture and timber products - Using specified process charts for cutting timber and timber-based materials, or preparing them on one's own - Preparing necessary materials and work equipment - Arranging the workplace by following rationality and safety of work and preservation of the environment Cutting timber and timber-based materials on woodworking benches - Configuring woodworking benches according to the operation under way, following occupational safety requirements and the set-up instructions of the bench - Measuring and marking simpler products in the operating unit and being able to use calibres and measurement standard details - Choosing cutting instruments according to the operation under way, changing cutting instruments, starting and switching off the benches independently and by following the safety requirements - Sawing, dressing, drilling, milling, turning and polishing materials by taking into account their characteristics, preventing errors and using necessary auxiliary tools - Following the safety requirements and using personal protective equipment, monitoring compliance to the safety requirements by the co-workers - Assessment of the manufactured product quality according to established requirements, finding out the possible causes of defects and remedying them
