3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

An offset printing machine operator is a qualified specialist whose main task is printing on an offset printing machine. An offset printing machine operator continuously monitors and checks the whole printing process; his/her tasks generally include the maintenance of the printing machine: cleaning, lubrication, adjusting, replacing supply materials required for keeping the printing machines in working order, maintaining a register thereof, etc. In addition to printing, the tasks of a printing machine operator include preparation of the printing machine and materials and adjusting the machine related to incoming work. The profession of an offset printing machine operator requires accuracy and commitment, as well as skills to handle and perform maintenance work on complicated equipment. Essential tasks of an offset printing machine operator include precise interpretation and performance of tasks according to the nature of the production, planning of work, rational and environmentally friendly use of tools.

Although the work of an offset printing machine operator is, in its main essence, individual, he/she must be ready for cooperation with other team members throughout the whole production process.

An offset printing machine operator must be prepared to develop and train himself/herself constantly in order to keep up with the development of technology, new equipment and work practices.
