3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

A textile craftsperson makes high-quality, aesthetic and functional textile handicraft items, following one specific traditional or modern textile technique or item group (e.g. needlework, weaving, national costumes, headwear, dolls). He/she prepares designs independently, makes and finishes unique items or mini-series.

He/she is ready to assume responsibility for the smooth work process of a working team and the work results of employees. A textile craftsperson knows how to organise and guide the activities of co-workers, apprentices or trainees, administrate an enterprise and cooperate with specialists of related fields.

He/she can solve problems and make proposals for improving the work results.

In his/her activities, a textile craftsperson appreciates following the ethical requirements of a master craftsperson, as well as occupational safety and environmental requirements.

A textile craftsperson markets his/her products, advises customers and provides services, e.g. supervising amateurs, conducting workshops, organising the work of hobby groups and carrying out events introducing textile work. He/she subcontracts, prepares designs, work instructions and drawings and carries out research.
