3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

Preparation of printing means checking and proofreading digital source material arrived to the print shop, imposition, RIP configuration, making print films or plates and, if required, designing printed works.

The profession of a graphic prepress operator requires accuracy and commitment, as well as skills to handle and perform maintenance work on complicated computers and equipment. Essential tasks of a graphic prepress operator include precise interpretation and performance of tasks according to the nature of the production, planning of work, rational and environmentally friendly use of tools.

A graphic prepress operator must be prepared to develop and train himself/herself constantly in order to keep up with the development of printing technology, software, new equipment and work practices.

Graphic prepress operator of level 4 is a qualified specialist whose work requires interest in modern printing and information technology. The work of a graphic prepress operator during the process of making the printed work is individual and involves responsibility. He/she should be ready for cooperation both inside the print shop as well as when communicating with customers.

The main working places of the representatives of the profession are print shops, reprographics offices, advertising agencies, marketing departments of enterprises, editor's offices and publishing houses.
