# 2. TRANSLATED TITLE OF THE CERTIFICATE (1) Log house builder, level 4 <sup>(1)</sup> if applicable. This translation has no legal status.

### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

A log house builder of level 4 is a skilled worker who erects log houses from industrially or manually manufactured components and/or modules. He/she works independently at constructing log walls and installation of rafters and performing other works (e.g. installs doors and windows, constructs floor structures and load-bearing structures of roof covering, constructs floors and framed structures, installs stairways, constructs and installs other wooden structures) following the design documentation and the occupational and environmental safety requirements. He/she can independently organise one's work and work in a team, in case of need supervises co-workers.

A log house builder of level 4 can specialise as a manual log house maker. A manual log house builder makes manually different components and modules of the log house as well as different log structures.

#### Mandatory competencies:

- Planning of work at the construction site;
- Preparation for work and organisation of work at the construction site;
- Making wooden joints:
- Erection of wooden framework walls of the log house;
- Erection of log walls:
- Construction of wooden floor structures and floors;
- Construction of roof structures:
- Installation of opening fillers (windows, doors, hatches);
- Installation of additional thermal insulation and external sidings on the log wall;
- Building saunas:
- Construction of outdoor facilities;
- Renovation.

Competencies related to specialisation:

- Preparation of building logs:
- Manual making of log house components and/or modules.
