3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

A fitter of railway vehicles, level 3, is an experienced skilled worker who maintains and repairs railway carriages in a railway repair workshop or repair depot, or railway vehicles in a repair depot.

His/her main tasks include the maintenance and repair of the assemblies (e.g., running gear, body and frame of vehicles and automatic brake systems, etc.) and systems of railway vehicles.

He/she follows the given instructions independently, assuming responsibility for the occupational safety of himself/herself and for his/her co-workers and ensures economical and effective work practices.

He/she may work alone and as a team member. His/her work presupposes communication with co-workers.

A fitter of railway vehicles, level 3, assumes responsibility, within the limits of his/her occupational qualification level, for the dangerous traffic situations caused by the tasks assigned to him/her related to the quality control, occupational safety and

A fitter of railway vehicles, level 3, is specialised in the maintenance and repair of railway carriages, or the maintenance and repair of locomotives or multiple-unit trains.

Mandatory competencies

- Repair of the running gear (chassis) of railway vehicles
- Repair of the attachments of railway vehicles
- Maintenance and repair of the body and frame of railway vehicles
- Repair of the brake equipment of railway vehicles

Competencies related to specialisation

- Maintenance and repair of power installations of locomotives or multiple-unit trains
- Maintenance and repair of the transmission of locomotives or multiple-unit trains
- Maintenance and repair of the transmission of passenger carriages

Optional competences

- Maintenance of the battery of passenger carriages or locomotives or multiple-unit trains
- Replacement of assistant systems of passenger carriages or multiple-unit trains

This document is designed to provide additional information about the specified certificate and does not have any legal status in itself. The format of the description is based on the following texts: Council Resolution 93/C 49/01 of 3 December 1992 on the transparency of qualifications, Council Resolution 96/C 224/04 of 15 July 1996 on the transparency of vocational training certificates, and Recommendation 2001/613/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 10 July 2001 on mobility within the Community for students, persons undergoing training, volunteers, teachers and trainers.
