3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

The work of the cleaner includes cleaning and maintaining various work and living environments. The cleaner knows the reasons for staining and contamination, he/she knows surface coating materials and can use detergents, work equipment, devices and machines economically and in a way that spares the health and the environment.

The cleaner works independently and according to instructions. In the profession of the cleaner, one can specialise as a specialised cleaner or a housekeeping attendant of accommodation establishment. The work of the specialised cleaner includes one-time thorough cleaning of surfaces and treating these with protective substances. The duties of the specialised cleaner do not include maintenance cleaning.

The work of the housekeeping attendant of an accommodation establishment includes cleaning of hotel rooms, changing bed linen, ensuring that the hotel room has necessary accessories.

Parts of work:

- 1 Preparation for work
- Planning of cleaning works
- Choosing and preparation of cleaning accessories/machines
- Choosing and dosing of detergent

2 Spring-cleaning

- Cleaning of furniture and objects
- Cleaning of walls, ceilings, windows and floors
- Cleaning and arranging of cleaning accessories and machines

3 Maintenance cleaning

- Cleaning of furniture and objects
- Cleaning of walls and floors
- Cleaning and arranging of cleaning accessories and machines

Parts of work related to specialisation:

Housekeeping attendant of accommodation establishment

- 4 Housekeeping
- Changing and arranging of bed linen, bathroom textiles
- Arranging of hygiene accessories, utensils, advertising materials, minibar, etc.
