3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

Stage worker, level 3, assembles and disassembles the stage design and installs stage decorations according to the instructions of the stage master and the stage plan. Erects during the performance and during the interval stage decorations and rebuilds them, based on the lessons learned in rehearsals. According to the instructions, makes minor improvements in the stage design.

Participates in outings, where, in addition to regular stage work also loads decoration elements safely and optimally in the vehicle under the instructions of the stage master.

Works under instructions of a stage master and independently in acquired work segments.

The work requires close interaction with the team and close colleagues (lights, sound, ?) for achieving a good and safe result and for better understanding of the production as a whole.

Work components:

- 1. Preparation of the performance:
- assembly of the stage design;
- Ensuring the maintenance of the stage scene of the director and the artist.
- 2. Execution of the performance:
- Rebuilding of the stage design during the performance;
- Performing (special) effects on the stage.
- 3. Disassembly and storage of the stage decoration:
- disassembly of the stage design:
- storage of the stage design:
- transport of the stage design;
- maintenance of the stage block.

Stage worker, stage employee, stage decoration assembler, stage technician.
