3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES
<p>The coastal fisherman, level 4, is a skilled worker who is engaged in fishing and in the primary handling of fish. In addition, the duties include the maintenance, arrangement and preparation of traps for fishing, the use and maintenance of technical gear required for fishing, and the preparation of the catch for sale and storage. The coastal fisherman uses the fishing methods and fishing gear permitted in his work. He/she complies with the requirements of the legislation governing fishing.</p> <p>Coastal fisherman, level 4, operates independently and is responsible for its activities in accordance with the requirements of the legislation.</p> <p>The certificate of the coastal fisherman, level 4, entitles to be entered as a fisherman on the fishing permit in accordance with the Fishing Act.</p> <p>Work components:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Primary processing, preparation for sale and storage of the fish catch <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Determination of the quantity and quality of the catch. - Sorting of catch. - Preservation of the quality of the catch. - Giving added value to the catch (valuation). - Preparation of the catch for sale.
