3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

A vehicle surface maintenance technician / tyre technician performs cleaning and maintenance work of the paint coating of motor vehicles, mobile machines, small machines and trailers (hereinafter: vehicles), interior materials, body parts and engine compartment, and work associated with tyres. Cleaning of a vehicle means removing dirt using appropriate technology, and maintenance means finishing the cleaned surfaces with suitable technology. Tyre work means the replacement of tyres and performance of related work.

The objective of work is to clean surfaces and provide maintenance service on a professional level.

A vehicle surface maintenance technician / tyre technician determines the type, extent and causes of the soiling of surfaces and proposes correct solutions for cleaning and maintenance. He/she has skills in working manually with professional cleaning and maintenance products using appropriate equipment, and knows how to use materials and devices required for tyre work.

A vehicle surface maintenance technician / tyre technician applies environment-friendly work practices and follows the occupational safety and health requirements.

A vehicle surface maintenance technician / tyre technician follows in his/her work the given orders, technical instructions, safety requirements and quality characteristics set for the work.

The materials and technologies used in the profession are often renewed and the materials used in the construction of vehicles are in a constant change. Thus, constant individual development is essential.

A vehicle surface maintenance technician / tyre technician may work alone and as a team member. To a certain extent, he/she may need supervision in new situations. His/her work presupposes communication with co-workers and customers.

Competencies

- Cleaning and maintenance of the vehicle paint, including glass surfaces
- Cleaning and maintenance of wheel arches, tyres, wheels and door openings
- Cleaning and maintenance of vehicle interior and surface coatings
- Cleaning of vehicle engine compartment and maintenance of surfaces
- Washing the bottom of the vehicle
- Changing tyres
- Condition assessment of assemblies located in the wheel arches
- Tyre repair work
