## 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

Construction Site Manager of level 5 works as specialist in charge at construction sites.

As Construction Site Manager, management skills are also important in addition to professional knowledge and skills.

Construction Site Manager is responsible for the technical and economic activities on the site and for safety at the construction site. He manages construction work and verifies whether the work has been done in compliance with project documentation and construction standards.

Construction Site Manager of this level is entitled to act as a direct contractor (specialist in charge) in all areas of specialisation within the following limits of competence

General building and finishing works:

- Building works of houses and other buildings of class CC1 according to the EVS-EN 1990:2002+NA:2002 standard according to specialisation

Construction of Technical Systems:

- Building of technical systems and internal utility systems of houses and other buildings of class CC1 according to the EVS-EN 1990:2002+NA:2002 standard according to specialisation

In case of the construction of more complex objects, the construction site manager of level 5 is entitled to act only by being subcontracted.

Construction site manager, level 5 gives the right to manage construction site works only within the limits described in the professional standard.

Competencies:

- Preparation of construction tender
- Preparation and planning of construction
- Resource management
- Management and organisation of construction works
- Assuring work safety at building sites
- Ensuring the quality of construction works
- Transfer of construction works
- Energy-efficient construction
