- General construction and technical data of cars and trailers
- Purpose and working principles of car aggregates, joints, systems and mechanisms
- Construction, basis of manufacture and assembly and construction parameters of car and trailer bodies (hereinafter car bodies)
- Quality requirements to repairs, maintenance and car body technician works for car bodies
- Reading technical drawings and figures, using catalogues and other instruction materials. Technical measurements.
- Technology of car body repair and maintenance works and tinworks
- Repair and maintenance materials used in processing and tinworks of car bodies
- Preventing potential technological errors in processing car bodies and tinworks
- Determining the repair needs of car bodies
- Assessing and calculating the necessary volume of work, planning the order of works
- Disassembly, repairs, assembly, finishing, corrosion protection and corrosion removal of car bodies
- Tools and equipment of a car body technician and the principles of use
- Tools and equipment of a car body technician, safe and purposeful use
- Welding (certificate of electric and gas welder)
