<b>3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES</b>
<p>The work of a chorus conductor is creative, presupposing musical training. A chorus conductor is interpreter of vocal music whose work tasks include teaching songs to the chorus and performing them in concert. The objective of the work is artistic conducting of the chorus and providing a high class musical experience to the audience. The work of chorus conductor is essentially pedagogical and presupposes, in addition to the musical skills also independent work with the chorus and knowledge of methodology and psychology.</p> <p>Conductor, EstQF Level 6 works with their choir as a conductor, or with a high-level concert choir with a large repertoire as an assistant conductor. They participate in competitions and festivals and give concerts with their choir(s). Their choirs participate actively in concert activities.
