3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

The work of a fire safety specialist includes fire risk assessment, fire safety consultation and guidance for building managers, owners, etc., provision of relevant training and carrying out awareness work to prevent fires and other accidents.

A fire safety specialist works independently and in a team, their work requiring communication with co-workers and clients.

Fire Safety Specialist, Level 5 (EstQF) is capable of:

- assessing fire risks;
- assessing structural measures for fire safety;
- assessing (a) fire safety management (plan) in an organisation; and
- providing advice on fire safety.

In addition, the specialist can also:

- prepare and carry out fire safety training and drills.
