### 3. PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCIES

The aim of a warehouse worker's job is to ensure the optimal temporary storage of materials and goods in the supply chain and to provide value-added services.

Warehouse Manager, Level 5 organises and leads warehouse operations and the movement of information related to them. They plan and use the warehouse's resources and organise stocktaking.

A warehouse manager is able to execute all procedures in the warehouse, incl. relocating and issuing goods. A warehouse manager works either independently or in a team as the team leader. Independently, they can manage all types of situations, solve problems, communicate with clients and co-workers in an appropriate manner and choose and implement modern warehouse and information technology, methods and tools to find new solutions.

A warehouse manager is responsible for the maintenance and prudent use of the warehouse's stock.

A holder of a Warehouse Manager, Level 5 occupational qualification certificate is able to fulfil the following tasks:

- 1 Receipt of goods
- Organisation of the receipt of goods
- Arrangement of storage units
- 2 Storage of goods
- Organisation of the storage of goods
- Organisation and maintenance of storage areas
- 3 Issuing of goods
- Organisation of the issuing of goods
- Drafting shipping documentation
- 4 Warehouse planning
- -G eneral warehouse planning
- Planning the use of warehouse technology
- Planning the storage process
- 5 Management of warehouse resources
- Tactical management
- Operational management
